### THE GIFT GALLERY

The Gift Gallery is in the front of the second floor in Washington Hall. It was the first Colorado courtroom and still holds the judge's bench, witness chair and the jury risers. There are walls, tables, racks and glass cases for display.

The Gift Gallery is not juried; items will be accepted at the GCA's discretion. These items represent the best of the membership. Artists not entering the Juried Show may pay the \$35 membership fee to participate in the Gift Gallery and Bin Art. This will also admit your work for the Members Show.

Items may be priced up to \$150 for the Gift Gallery and Bin Work, however, we strongly encourage artists to submit fun and attractive items in the \$5 to \$50 range. Our gallery attracts both the Opera patrons and tourists who chance to walk in. Both are often very interested in less expensive items that are suitable for souvenirs and gifts.

### BIN ART

On either side of the stairs as you arrive in the Gift Gallery are long bins for display of Bin Art: unframed flat art such as photos, paintings, and drawings. The Bins are open to artists who have been accepted in the Juried Show and current members. The pieces must be covered in clear plastic. We encourage you to mat your work, as it enhances its beauty.

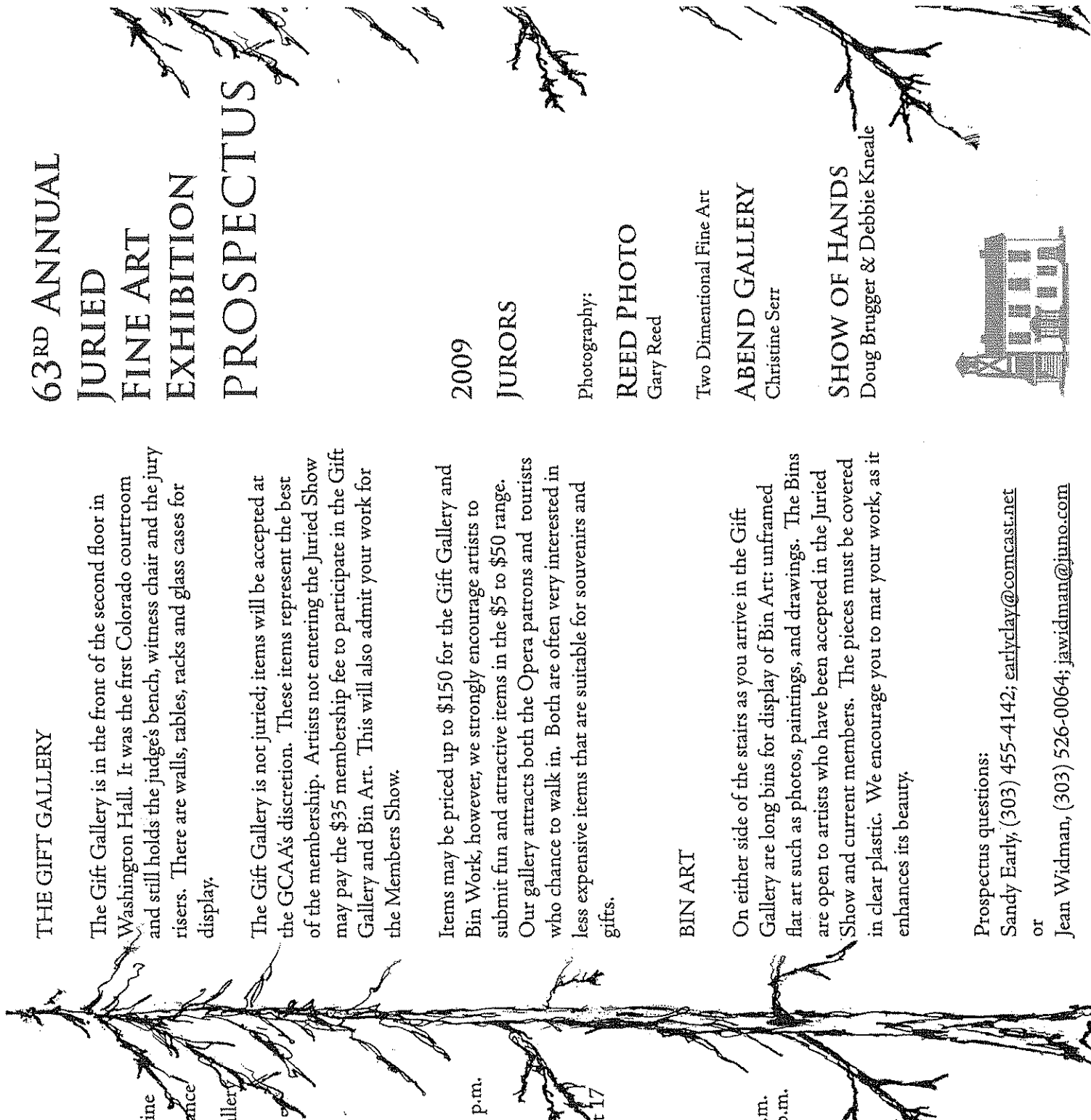

FOR THE 2009 JURIED SHOW**

The Juried Show is open to all artists living in the Rocky Mountain States of Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Utah and Wyoming.

Entry Fee is \$35. You may submit up to three (3) pieces in two-dimensional fine art, and five (5) pieces in three-dimensional fine art.

Entry Images for Jurying: You may submit one image per two-dimensional entry, and two images per three-dimensional entry. Digital images in jpeg format 300 dpi @ 4" x6"  
= 1200 x 1800 pixels, on a CD.

We are only accepting digital entries this year. You can convert your slides to digital images on a CD at Reed Photo-Imaging, 888 Federal Blvd. Denver, telephone: 303-573-8084 for a cost of \$10 for 5 images. Tell them it is for GCAA to get this rate.

Your entry must include

- images,
- entry forms,
- fees
- a SASE.

Images of the entries accepted will be held by GCAA until delivery of artwork.

## CATEGORY GUIDELINES

### TWO-DIMENSIONAL FINE ARTS:

3 entries allowed.

Drawing - Dry media including chalk, charcoal, pastels, crayon or inks/oils applied by pen or brush.

Graphics & Printing: Works in which the artist manipulates the plates, stone or screens by hand. All must be signed and numbered as a limited edition. Photogravure, photocopies, and/or offset reproductions will be rejected.

Mixed Media: Includes both two- and three-dimensional work incorporating more than one material.

Painting: Created in oils, acrylics, watercolor, etc. Reproductions are prohibited.

Photography: Photographic prints made from the artist's original negative, positive, or digital file, processed by the artist or under his or her supervision.

### THREE-DIMENSIONAL FINE ARTS:

5 entries allowed.

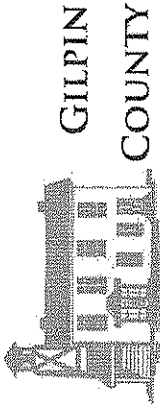
Ceramics: All original clay work other than jewelry. No machine-made or mass-produced work permitted. Each piece must be signed.

Fiber: Includes basketry, embroidery, weaving, leatherwork, and paper making. No machine tooling, screening or other mass-produced forms. No factory-produced wearable items, regardless of enhancement.

Glass: No forms of mass-produced work permitted. Free-standing work must be stable.

Jewelry: All jewelry must be handcrafted originals. No commercial casts, molds, or production-studio work accepted.

Metal and Woodwork: All non-sculptural non-jewelry work from metal and wood. It must be original work that is hand tooled, worked, carved or turned.

From Denver:

Head west on I-70 out of Denver past Floyd Hill. Take exit #243 on the new Central City Parkway. Go 8 miles into Central City. You will come in on Spring Street. This ends at Eureka Street. Turn left and go 1 1/2 blocks. The gallery is on your right.

or

Take 6th Ave. west out of Denver. Turn Left at Hwy. 119 and go up Clear Creek Canyon. Continue through Black Hawk. Turn Left at the sign to Central City and go 1 mile to Central City. You are on Eureka Street. The gallery is 1/2 block after Main Street on your right.

### Parking:

There is free parking at the Century Casino. You will see a sign at the corner of Spring and Gregory.

We are welcome to use the opera parking lot up the hill on the left if there is no opera going on.
